Waikerie Pavement Rehabilitation Night works notice

We are improving safety and supporting regional economic growth

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$87.5 million (80:20) to upgrade the Sturt Highway, between Renmark and Gawler to improve and freight efficiency and safety for road all users.

What's happening

We are undertaking pavement rehabilitation works on the Sturt Highway in Waikerie in two locations, between Ian Oliver Drive and Maggea Road, and between Strangman Road and Pope Road.

Early works, including site surveys and site mobilisation, will commence from Sunday, 17 November 2024, with major works commencing from Wednesday 20 November 2024, weather permitting.

How this affects you

To do these works safely, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions for the duration of the project.

From Sunday, 17 November 2024, the Sturt Highway, between lan Oliver Drive and Maggea Road, and between Strangman Road and Pope Road, Waikerie, will be reduced to a single lane during working hours. Temporary traffic signals will be in place throughout the areas to guide the flow of traffic.

Speed restrictions will remain in place throughout the area for the duration of the project.

During working hours, access to some side roads and individual property driveways within the work area may be temporarily restricted. Local detours will be in place if side road access is restricted. Please follow onsite signage for alternative routes and observe the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

Should temporary property access restrictions be required advance notice will be provided directly via our contractor, Fulton Hogan. Outside of working hours, local detours will be removed and normal access restored.

Outside of working hours, the Sturt Highway will be reopened to two-way traffic, however speed restrictions will remain in place. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow onsite signage.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however we will minimise disturbance as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphalting works are underway.

Major works are expected to be complete by late November 2024, weather permitting. Minor finishing works, including line marking will be undertaken following completion. Speed restrictions will remain in place until all works, including finishing works, are complete in late December 2024.
