## Works Update – vegetation removal

Works associated with the Heysen Tunnels upgrade works are progressing well, with works to install the new fire suppression system continuing.

### What's happening:

To allow us to finish the drainage structure for the new fire suppression system, additional vegetation removals are required in the area.

No significant or regulated trees will be removed and every effort has been made to minimise the impact to vegetation wherever possible.

### How this affects you:

There will be no impact to road users.

Access to the truck stop will be maintained. Please observe traffic management signage.
