

Drayton and Chief Street Pocket Parks

Project update

We've nearly finished preparing the vacant land at Chief and Drayton Streets to be used as a future pocket park. Once our works are complete, the City of Charles Sturt will take over the space for community use

What's happening

Drayton Street will be closed for a short time during the week of Monday 21 July 2025 to remove the construction equipment from Drayton Street pocket park site. The closure will be in place from just north of the underpass to just south of the underpass.

We'll start delivering topsoil during the week of Monday 28 July 2025. The soil will be delivered to the Chief Street site and to the Drayton Street site as required.

Site preparation is anticipated to be finalised by Friday, 8 August 2025.

What to expect

You will still be able to access your property, and traffic management and signage will be in place.

While soil is being delivered, there will be a large number of trucks entering Chief Street from Torrens Road. There will also be trucks moving between the Chief Street and Drayton Street sites.

Please take care when travelling through the area, look both ways before crossing the road and observe traffic management signage.
