Augusta Highway Safety Barrier Installation

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$500 million (80:20) over ten years to improve the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

What's happening

We are upgrading and installing new safety barriers on the Augusta Highway between Lochiel and Collinsfield. Works will include the removal of existing safety barrier and installation of new barriers along this section of the Augusta Highway.

How this affects you

To safely undertake these works, there will be changes to existing traffic conditions. During work hours speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout work areas.

Outside of work hours, speed restrictions will remain in place as needed until all works are complete in mid-October 2025.

Please follow onsite traffic signage and the directions of traffic controllers.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict access.
