

Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place Junction Upgrade

Night works

We're upgrading the Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place Junction Upgrade

These works are jointly funded 50:50 by the Australian and South Australian governments through the Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program, which replaces the Heavy Vehicle Safety and Productivity Program (HVSP).

What's happening

Works on the Porter Street, Liverpool Street and Railway Place Junction in Port Lincoln are continuing. From Wednesday 15 April 2026, in addition to the ongoing day works, nightworks and weekend works are required until project completion.

All works are expected to be complete in Mid 2026, weather permitting.

How this affects you

There will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe. Speed and lane restrictions will be required while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Outside of working hours, some restrictions will need to remain in place, until completion.

Access to businesses will be maintained at all times, however, if there is the need for short-term access impacts, we will contact you directly in advance.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby properties as much as practically possible.
