

# Tram Network Improvements

## Project update

### What's happening

We'll be carrying out works at tram Stop 2 Wayville and the pedestrian mazeways between Joslin Street and Rogers Street to undertake additional painting on the newly installed fencing.

The works will involve removing sections of fencing for painting, putting temporary fencing in place while this happens, and then reinstalling the repainted fencing.

The work will be carried out in stages over several weeks.

### How this affects you

Works will start in late June and, from time to time, temporary closures of pedestrian crossings will be needed. One crossing will remain open at all times, and signs will help guide pedestrians to the nearest open crossing.

Most works will take place during the day. Some night works may be needed to safely complete certain activities and help reduce impacts on tram services.

There will be no impact to tram services as part of these works.
