The Department has received a number of enquiries from Motor Driving Instructors who, as a result of the Optus data breach, have either:

- Changed their driver's licence number, or
- Have had students who have changed their permit/licence number.

For Authorised Examiners who have changed their driver's licence number, please ensure your new licence number is used on Certificates of Competency and also on Monthly Returns submitted.

If you have a student/client who has changed their driver's licence/permit number, you can verify this via:

- The new licence/permit, or
- Their digital licence/permit, or
- By having the client log into the mySAGOV account and show the receipt for the transaction, or
- The production of a paper licence or permit.
