What's happening

Due to a number of program impacts works to install updated lighting at the Augusta Highway and Pareora Road junction have been delayed. Works will now be undertaken from Monday, 14 October until mid-November 2024, weather permitting.

How this affects you

To undertake these works safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout the area during work hours. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and observe signage.

Augusta Highway will remain open at all times.

Outside of work hours, all traffic restrictions will be removed.
