

Grange Road Resurfacing

Night works notice

We are undertaking maintenance works to improve the road surface and safety for all road users.

What's happening

We are undertaking resurfacing works on Grange Road between Military Road and Frederick Road, and on Frederick Road near the intersection of Grange Road.

To minimise impacts to road users these works will be undertaken at night.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe there will be changes to existing traffic conditions.

Short term detours will be in place throughout the area during work hours, please follow signage for directions to alternate routes.

Temporary speed and lane restrictions will be in effect during work hours, with temporary speed restrictions remaining until all works are complete in late-September 2025. Please plan your trips, observe signage and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

There will be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep noise to a minimum. You may also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

Access to properties may be impacted at times. Should temporary property access restrictions be required, impacted residents will be contacted directly in advance.

Bus services in the area may be temporarily impacted. Please visit adelaidemetro.com.au for more information.
