## Project update - December 2025

### What's happening

Construction of the intersection upgrade is progressing well with the new signals expected to be operational by early 2026.

Works are continuing over the coming months and will include:

- ongoing construction of Rosslyn Street link road
- carrying out final asphaltting works and line marking
- installing footpaths and new street lighting
- landscaping.

**No works will occur during the holiday break from Saturday 20 December 2025 to Sunday 4 January 2026.**

## What you need to know

All construction activities will be carried out with the health and safety of the local community as our top priority. We will keep everyone up to date as the project progresses.

### Night works

While most of our work will be carried out during the day, some outside of standard construction hours will be required to minimise impacts to road users.

Required night works will typically take place Sunday to Friday, between 7pm and 6am. There will be no works Saturday nights. Advance notice will be provided closer to the time.

### Traffic management

To keep everyone safe, speed and lane restrictions will continue to be in place as required

Property access throughout the works will be maintained via detour routes, wherever possible. If we need to temporarily restrict driveway access, advance notice will be provided.
