

40 km/h school speed limits

Works notice – South Road

Improving safety for children travelling to and from school

A new 40 km/h time-based speed limit has been introduced near schools on South Australian roads that have speed limits of 50 km/h or higher. This will improve children's safety and help them when they travel to and from school.

As a result of the program, timed reduced speed limits will apply on South Road (in the vicinity of Black Forest Primary School) from mid-August 2026.

What's happening

Works will be taking place on South Road, between Forest Avenue and Byron Road, to install new electronic and static signage as part of the 40 km/h school speed limits rollout.

To minimise impacts to traffic, works will be undertaken at night, between the hours of 7pm and 6am. Work zones will move along South Road as works are completed.

These works will be undertaken intermittently from Monday 27 July 2026, with completion expected in mid-August 2026.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe while works are undertaken there will be changes to traffic conditions. Speed restrictions and lane closures will be in place along South Road during working hours. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

40 km/h school speed limits

The new 40 km/h time-based school speed limit will be in place along South Road during the following times on school days:

- 8:00am to 9:30am
- 2:00pm to 4:00pm

This excludes weekends, public holidays and school holidays.

Speed limits will be enforced from the date of completion at each site.
