

## Nairne Intersection Upgrade

## Night Works Notification

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) is delivering improved safety and traffic efficiency through the construction of a four-way, single lane roundabout realigning the Woodside Road and Saleyard Road T-junctions with the Old Princes Highway, Nairne. The State Government has committed \$13 million to this project which is being delivered as part of the Adelaide Hills Intersections Upgrade Initiative.

Early site establishment works are underway. While the majority of works are being undertaken during the day, some night works are required to ensure the works can be undertaken safely and efficiently.

These works include the relocation of services and the installation of conduits and stormwater drainage.

Works will be undertaken at night from Sunday, 11 July 2021, for approximately six weeks, weather permitting. Hours of work are between 6pm and 6am, 7 days a week.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

## What to expect during night works

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the T-junctions will remain open to traffic at all times. Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Individual service providers, including SA Power Networks and Telecommunication providers, will advise you separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.







Public transport services will remain operational, however, bus stops in the vicinity of the works, along Old Princes Highway and Woodside Road, may require temporary relocation. Advance notice of any temporary changes will be provided at bus stops and on the Adelaide Metro website <a href="https://www.adelaidemetro.com.au">www.adelaidemetro.com.au</a> when required.

Site establishment works will also continue to be undertaken during the day until late July 2021, weather permitting. Standard hours of work are Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 6pm.

Major works for the project will commence in late July 2021, and are expected to be completed early 2022, weather permitting.

The Department appreciates your patience whilst these important works are undertaken.
